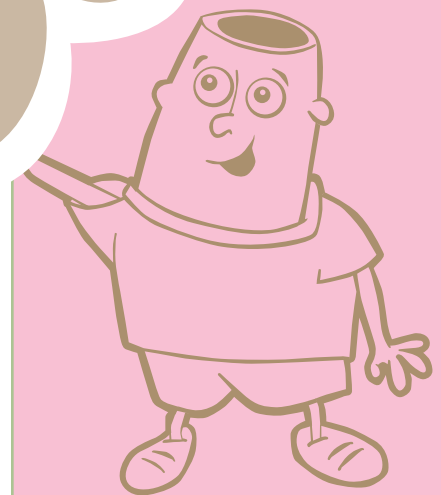

POLICIES AND TERMS OF MARSHALL SCHOOL 2010 SUMMER PROGRAMS

Registration Details. To register for summer programs, send a completed application form along with a \$50 non-refundable deposit. Check or money order should be made payable to Marshall School.

- The \$50 deposit is applied toward tuition, and the balance of summer programs fees will be due one week prior to the course date.
- Classes and lessons are filled on a first-come, first-served basis. Students should register for programs based on their grade for the next school year.
- Registration forms and deposits and/or fees should be received one week prior to the start of camp.
- Parents will receive confirmation of completed registrations by e-mail. At this time we will also send an emergency form and field trip slip, if applicable, to be completed and returned by the first day of camp; no child will be allowed to participate in programming without the emergency form on file, and no child will be allowed to attend field trips without a signed permission slip.

Cancellations. There will be no refunds if a student withdraws from our programs while they are in session, except in the case of extended illness. If your plans change and you need to cancel your registration before programming begins, all but your \$50 deposit will be refunded. If, due to lack of enrollment we have to cancel a class, your full tuition will be refunded. You will be notified in the case of such an event.

Extended Day. Programming will be provided from 7:30 - 9:00 am and again from 3:30 - 5:00 pm every day that programs are in session. The extended day program is centered in the library and provides a variety of self-directed activities for campers to begin or end the day. The cost is \$15 per time slot per week.

All campers spending the entire day need to provide their own lunch.
