Global Scholars Program

Marshall School offers the opportunity for qualified international students to apply for a scholarship of up to \$15,000 applied toward tuition and fees for its academic year program. Tuition and fees are \$42,730. Tuition and fees include housing for 10 months, food in the residence hall, books, transportation, technology fees, and field trips. Medical insurance and school lunch/snack fund are extra, and cost an additional \$2700 per year. The unused portion of the lunch/snack fee is returned to families prior to graduation.

To be considered for a scholarship, applicants must demonstrate:

- 1. Financial need as demonstrated in the international financial aid application. Strong academic habits, as demonstrated through prior two years academic transcripts and letters of recommendation.
- 2. Service towards others, and a clear vision of how they hope to contribute to the world around them, as demonstrated in the personal essay portion of the application.
- 3. Students must meet the minimum English language requirement as determined by English proficiency exam such as the iELTS, SLEP, TOEFL or TOEFL Junior. Marshall understands that these exams may not be available in the student's home country, and in that case, a Skype interview with the Director of the International Program will determine the level of English proficiency.
- 4. Personal and social skills the poise the student for success in an American High School environment.
